Show Rules & Conditions of Entry

1. The show will be conducted under AQHA rules. The judge's decision is final.
2. Youth age to be taken from 1st August 2021.
3. The committee reserves the right to change the order of events before or during the show. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be aware of any changes.
4. The committee, its affiliates and sponsors will not be held responsible for any injury incurred, damage to or loss of goods. All competitors compete at their own risk.
5. Disputes Committee will consist of Show Manager, Committee Member and one Contestant.
6. The NEQHA Committee reserves the right to prohibit any person from showing or attending any horse in the show ring, and to remove any person or horse from the grounds without being liable for compensation
7. Rookie Riders are not to compete on colts or stallions
8. The consumption of ALCOHOL is prohibited by the AQHA in marshalling areas, working arenas or show pen and contest arenas

Competitor's/participants at any event run by NEQHA have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect, and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors and to uphold the rules and regulations of the NEQHA and the AQHA at all times.

Competitors/participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.

All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contestant, the parent/guardian must also approve the entry form on Nominate. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event. All competitors, competitors accompanying party, spectators and workers at any NEQHA event are required to abide by all COVID guidelines advertised/in operation at the show by the NEQHA committee/workers and/or venue owner. If any attendee refuses to abide by these regulations, they will be required to leave the grounds immediately.

Guidelines

The NEQHA is an affiliate of the Australian Quarter Horse Association (AQHA) Our judges refer to the AQHA rule book for **sanctioned classes**.

Classes that run under NEQHA rules with AQHA guidelines are referred to as '**Non-sanctioned classes**'

All participants must be a member of the NEQHA, or the AQHA, OR pay a day membership

To qualify for End of Year High Point awards, you must be a full financial member of the NEQHA and ride at a minimum of three (3) shows in the show year.

NEQHA Rules Non-Sanctioned Class Divisions;

*** Rookie /Rookie Youth** , - A rider who has **never won the equivalent** youth, amateur, open, junior, or senior horse class at a **sanctioned** western event or, won an NEQHA * Rookie end of year High Point award. The focus of these classes is to encourage those who are new to western showing.

*** Any Handed** - A horse and rider combination who together, **have never won an equivalent** youth, amateur, junior or senior horse, open or aged class at a **sanctioned event**. This class allows open riders to show young or green horses and gives new members an opportunity to show amongst open riders. Sometimes referred to as 'practice' runs.

Rules and Conditions for Rookie / Rookie Youth and Any Handed classes

- ✓ Horses are not required to be registered
- ✓ Children must be 7 years of age and over
- ✓ May compete in any safe Saddle including western, stock, fender or English
- ✓ May use any legal snaffle bit, bosal/ hackamore or Bridle/shank bit (See AQHA rule book)
- ✓ if using a bridle, horses can be ridden 1 or 2 handed but must not change from one back to two hands after entering the show arena
- ✓ Riders must wear a long sleeve shirt, jeans or jodhpurs, western hat or helmet and boots
- ✓ Horses must be 3 years of age and over

AQHA RULES

Sanctioned Classes

Junior Horse, Senior Horse and All Age/Open - all breeds are accepted but must be registered with their breed association, society or studbook.

Amateur – Non-Professional rider under 50 years of age

Select Amateur Non-Professional rider 50 years of age and over

Youth - Riders 7-18 years of age. Not required to hold ownership of the horses they ride

Amateurs are required to verify their Amateur Status by providing a copy of their amateur card to the Show Secretary: admin@neqha.com.au

Amateur's horses must be owned or leased by the amateur or immediate family member
